- Updating of Program of Studies.
- Revision to School Profile Data Sheets sent to Colleges/Universities.
- Revisions to curriculum maps/scope and sequence to reflect higher level of rigor in honors level courses.
- Updating of criteria for enrollment in honors level courses.
- Updating of PowerSchool to reflect new weight to course.

Board may address honors level course as an action item at a future board meeting.
